A plot plan is a picture of a lot. *It must be drawn to scale* on an 8½" x 11" (or larger) piece of paper.

### It must show the following information:

- 1. Arrow showing North direction
- 2. Measurements of all the boundaries of the land (lot dimensions)
- 3. Location and dimensions of all structures on the property (houses, garages, sheds, pools, fences, etc.)
- 4. The shortest distance from the building to front lot line (front setback)
- 5. The shortest distance from the building to side lot line (side setback)
- 6. The shortest distance from the building to rear lot line (rear setback)
- 7. Location of driveway and access roads and road frontage measurement
- 8. Location of any easements
